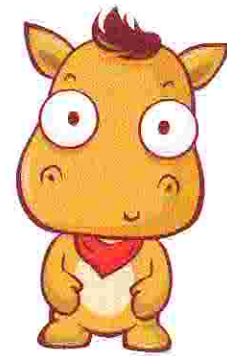




Equine Rabies



What is Equine rabies?

Equine Rabies is a highly fatal, contagious disease that affects the central nervous system of the horse.

Rabies is passed from animals through the saliva of an infected animal.

What are the symptoms?

- Lameness
- Focusing on the Bite Wound
- Poor Coordination
- Difficulty Swallowing
- Aggression and Dangerous Behavior
- In the disease's final stages, the animal becomes paralyzed and goes into convulsions.

How can I keep my horse from getting rabies?

- Vaccinate your horses !!!!!
- Rabies vaccination should be done yearly
- If you suspect there is an animal with rabies around your barn call animal control.

Is there a cure if my horse gets rabies?

- No treatment exists for rabies in horses.
- The disease is almost always fatal!
